The Dunn County Housing Authority provides a Housing Choice Voucher Program (Section 8) to eligible households that would like to reside in the rural areas of Dunn County. We serve...

ALL DUNN COUNTY AREAS/VILLAGES EXCLUDING THE MENOMONIE CITY LIMITS.

The rent voucher program is one way the Federal Government helps people with very low income, rent privately owned housing. Rent is based on 30% of an eligible household's adjusted gross income. All participants must locate housing that meets program payment standards on their own. Explanation of the process will be given to you during a meeting called a tenant briefing.

The current payment standards are listed by bedroom size below. A payment standard is NOT the amount of rent that will be approved by the program.

NOTE: Eligible bedroom size depends on household size and is determined by the housing authority.

NOTE: The limits listed below are what HUD defines as gross rent -orrent <u>PLUS ALL UTILITIES</u>. (not the approved rent to be charged by a landlord)

*If you locate rental housing that does not include <u>all</u> utilities, **YOU MUST MINUS** ~ \$150-\$350 from the amounts below (depends on bedroom size and type of heat).*

Once your application is received, you will be put on the **waiting list**. Completion of an application <u>does not</u> automatically qualify you for the program. It is only one step in the process.
